Reverend Alyce French Johnson

A native of Louisville, Kentucky, and oldest of five children born to the late Bro. George T. French, Sr. and Mother Dorothy Jewell French. She is the granddaughter of the Founders of Oak Grove Missionary Baptist Church, Reverend John Thomas French, and Mrs. Lucy Mae French; granddaughter of Sis. Dorothy Mae Galbreath Bush and the great-granddaughter of the late Mother Gladys G. Brewer, who was a charter member of Oak Grove for 50 years. Rev. French Johnson has been married to Deacon Joseph Johnson, Jr. for 37 years and together they have one son, Reverend John Quincy Johnson, Sr. and a daughter-in-love, the former Jacqueline Beatty. Her grandchildren, Jasmine, John, Jr. and Julianna are the apples of her eye.



Reverend French Johnson began her career at Transit Authority of River City (TARC) in 1977 as a Customer Service Representative and by the grace of God, moved through the ranks in various positions culminating with her appointment as Assistant Executive Director, a position from which she retired on September 1, 2016.

She earned her Masters of Arts degree in management from Webster University in Jeffersonville, Indiana, having earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Communication from Spalding University in Louisville, Kentucky. Reverend French Johnson is a member of the 2001 Class of Leadership Louisville and a 2003 Bingham Fellow. She formally served on the Advisory Boards of the YMCA Safe Place and the Lincoln Foundation.

Reverend French Johnson was licensed in 2000 and ordained in 2008 at the Oak Grove Missionary Baptist Church. She has served faithfully as the Administrative Assistant under the leadership of Pastor Thomas Henry French. On August 13, 2017, upon Reverend Thomas French's retirement, Reverend French Johnson was installed as pastor of Oak Grove Missionary Baptist Church.

Like David, two things Reverend French Johnson fervently believes she has never seen are: (1) the righteous forsaken, and (2) His seed begging bread.

Reverend Doctor Brianna K. Parker

– known as Rev. Bri – is a highly sought-after preacher, public speaker, millennial engagement coach and ministry consultant. She is the curator and founder of the Black Millennial Café (BMC), a consulting practice and data resource center for persons seeking healthy engagement with Black millennials and faith.



Through the Black Millennial Café, Rev. Bri has developed a suite of services to improve outreach to millennials. She lectures and presents empirical data on Black millennials and faith nationwide. BMC resources include a young adult ministry revitalization kit, a millennial bible study series, on-demand training curriculums, coaching and other customized programming for churches and organizations. The lessons from her research and experience as a millennial and millennial expert have been used to create her digital Bible study curriculum for young adults titled, "Open Table: Where Everyone Gets a Seat" and will be culled into a forthcoming book, "What Google Can't Give." Significant research backs Rev. Bri's work as she was the first to hold quantitative and qualitative data on black millennials and faith, a neglected research demographic. She holds a Bachelor of Arts in political science from Arizona State University, a Master of Divinity in pastoral care and counseling from Fuller Theological Seminary, a Master of Arts in church-state studies from Baylor University, and a Doctor of Ministry from Virginia Union University's Samuel Dewitt Proctor School of Theology. Reverend Bri served Friendship-West Baptist Church for nearly a decade with Reverend Frederick D. Haynes, III who ordained her. She also served Paul Quinn College for seven years as an adjunct professor and Coordinator of College Assembly. She was awarded the Norman Vincent Peale preaching scholarship and the Mary McLeod Bethune Religion Award from the National Council of Negro Women, and she is a Silver Lifetime Member of the NAACP.

When not running BMC, Rev. Bri serves as a full-time professor of religion at Jarvis Christian College.
