
ELLA HOUSTON DANIELS




EXAVIER DOUGLAS

C.H.O.I.C.E. CELEBRATES 37 YEARS! DR. DAWN SHANNON AND LIZ SIAS-SHANNON.



We take great pride in the remarkable achievements of C.H.O.I.C.E. (Children Have Options In Choosing Experiences) Inc. has achieved over the last 37 years. Established in 1987, we have served over 1,000 JCPS students and their families in understanding the impact of childhood trauma and the power of resilience. C.H.O.I.C.E.'s mission is to deliver prevention and early intervention alcohol and other drug services to empower youth and adolescents to make positive, drug-free, and non-violent lifestyle decisions. Our work aims to equip students with resilience, coping, and interpersonal tools to navigate life's choices to the best of their abilities. For 37 years, C.H.O.I.C.E. has been dedicated to offering these vital services within J.C.P.S. during school hours. A standout initiative within our array of programs is the Dare to Dream Sports Leadership and Mentoring Program, a transformative endeavor using cross-age mentoring. The Dare to Dream Sports Leadership Mentoring program encompassed high school athletes (9th -12th grade) from Fern Creek (all genders) and Iroquois High School (females only) who mentored students (4th - 5th grade) from Watterson (males only) and Whitney Young Elementary (females only). It is now in its 30th year of partnership with JCPS. This program pairs high school athletesof both genders with gender-specific mentees from elementary school. All students have been impacted by childhood trauma in some way. Weekly group sessions and bi-weekly mentoring experiences, guided by facilitators, create a supportive environment for growth and development for Mentors and Mentees. Our activities strengthen young people's resilience, introduce them to coping mechanisms, increase social-emotional learning, and promote academic motivation in participants. For the 2023-2024 school year, we had 11 seniors, 9 who graduated on time, and four(4) Black male participants who overcame their challenges and graduated high school early in December 2023. Three of the four early graduates have committed to 4-year Universities and received athletic and academic scholarships, a testament to their hard work and the effectiveness of our program. 85% of participants reported an increase in their level of resilience, and 80% reported a decrease in involvement in risk behaviors.
