Types of Prayers

- ***Petition*** – Asking for oneself. “Lord, create in me a clean heart and renew a right spirit in me.” Psalm 51:10
 - ***Intercession*** – Asking for others. “So, we have not stopped praying for you since we first heard about you. We ask God to give you complete knowledge of his will and to give you spiritual wisdom and understanding.” Colossians 1:9
 - ***Praise*** – Telling God how great he is. “For the Lord is a great God, and a great King above all gods.” Psalm 94:3
 - ***Lament*** – Praying and crying out our sorrows to God. “Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of thy name: And deliver us, and purge away our sins, for thy name sake.” Psalm 79:9
 - ***Confession*** – Admitting our sins to God. “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.” 1 John 1:9
 - ***Affirmation*** – Telling ourselves (while God listens) things that are true and helpful. “Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable – if anything is excellent or praiseworthy – think about such things.” Philippians 4:8
